Become a Certified Child Passenger Safety Technician (“CPST”)!



As a CPST you could:

- Check safety seats for recalls, expiration, appropriateness for child
- Educate parents on how to install their child safety seats
- Provide community education & training on child passenger safety
- Receive Maryland-specific seat check materials for your activities
- Attend free periodic update courses & training opportunities

About the CPST certification course:

- It's usually 3 days long
- It's offered 5-10 times/year in Maryland
- It combines classroom instruction, hands-on work with car seats and vehicles, and has a community safety seat check-up event at the end
- Open-book quizzes and skills tests are required
- It costs \$85 to register (a limited number of scholarships are available for qualifying healthcare/EMS personnel;
- Successful completion of the course gives CPST status for 2 years
